How do we understand what we see when visiting the Art Museum or experiencing visual art? In this program students will preview artworks from the *Volcano! Mount St. Helens in Art* and use class observation, hands-on activities and sharing to sharpen skills of perception and analysis as well as a command of visual design elements and principles.

Suggested Grades: 4-12

2 sessions: students will focus on observational strategies

4 sessions: students will learn observational strategies and create artwork practicing these strategies

In this residency, students will explore themes of the *Volcano!* exhibition by using movement to look at expressions of the natural forces in volcanic activity. Through creative improvisation and choreography, working individually and in groups, participants recreate lava flows, smoldering cinder cones, and, of course, explosive eruptions, all translated into movement based on their understanding of natural forces through observation and dialogue.
