Agreements and Expectations

This Museum belongs to everyone, and everyone belongs here. Our mission is to make sure that art from many different times, places, and cultures will always be available for you, your families, and future generations to come and see.

We need you to help us protect the art for everyone to enjoy!

Please:

- **Leave all food, drinks, and large bags** in your vehicle or on the storage racks on the Museum's lower level.
- Be excited and curious about the artwork, but do not touch it. **Keep about 12 inches of space** between your body and the artwork.
- Feel free to take photographs throughout the Museum, but be sure to **turn off your flash**, as bright lights can damage the artwork.
- Use **only pencils** in the Museum galleries. We recommend hard-backed notebooks or clipboards for writing and drawing. You may also place paper or notebooks on the floor, but please do not use the gallery walls.
- **Be considerate** of other Museum visitors by sharing space.
- **Limit Museum Gift Shop entry** to no more than 6 – 10 students at once, and only with adult supervision.
- Chaperones, please **stay with your student groups** and support them in honoring these agreements.
